Did you know that our newly forming Post Auxiliary should someday have more members than we do?

A VFW Auxiliary should ideally have more members than its parent Post because **Auxiliary eligibility is much broader**. While Post membership requires a veteran to have served in a combat zone, Auxiliary membership is open to multiple family members of an eligible veteran (spouses, parents, children, siblings, and grandchildren)

Members of the Auxiliary must be at least 16 years old.

“Every year when VFW goes to Capitol Hill to testify,” she said, “the Auxiliary membership number is counted in with the VFW. The larger the count, the more powerful our voice is.” - Ann Panteleakos, VFW.org

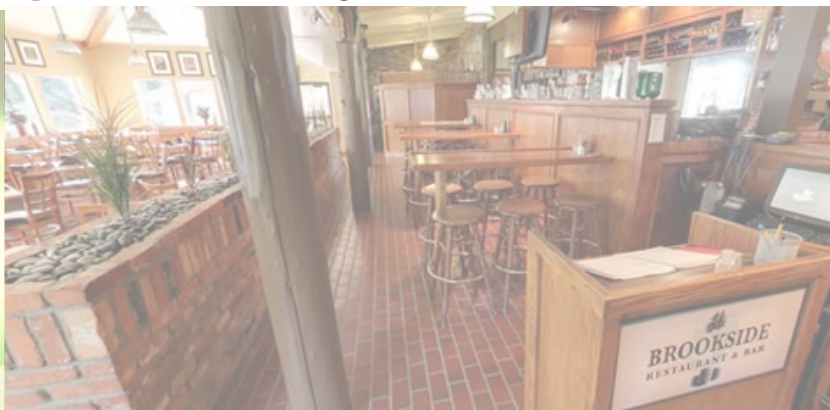
