

How to add "Veteran" to your Driver License / ID

First, take your DD214 and government identification to your nearest CVSO:

Next, Go online or call DMV for an appointment. Then bring your veteran Status Verification Form to DMV. Complete your application, pay any fees including the \$5 fee to add the Veteran Designation.



HOME IMPROVEMENT SERVICES APPLY NOW FOR <u>FREE</u> HOME REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS



Home improvement services are available to Rancho Cordova homeowners who meet the income guidelines. The funding is limited so those with the greatest need will be selected. The type and number of upgrades will vary per home. Work will occur in 2024-2025. There is NO COST to the homeowner.

Eligibility: Homeowners in Rancho Cordova whose income falls within the chart below.

The type of improvements and repairs may include safety and accessibility modifications, energy efficiency upgrades, carpentry, heating and air, roofs, fencing, exterior beautification, etc. Each selected homeowner will work with Rebuilding Together to identify needs, priorities and a schedule to complete the work. The work will be completed by volunteers, contractors, and employees.

What is the Renaissance Society?



The Renaissance Society of Sacramento happens at Sac State. It provides lifelong learning and community engagement for older adults. Learning opportunities include programs on widely varied subjects, from serious to amusing, proposed and presented by members. Cost is \$100.00 per year.

There are a wide variety of programs, five days a week. During the Fall 2024 semester, there are programs on Zoom Monday through Thursday. Other programs are at the Sac State campus on Fridays; some are in-person only, while others are a combination of in-person and Zoom.
